

Cala Montjoi's commitment to the environment:

ISO 14001

Cala Montjoi Holiday Resort enjoys a privileged location within the Cap de Creus Natural Park, 7 km from the town of Roses, in a peaceful cove surrounded by mountains. This setting makes it an ideal place to spend a few relaxing days or an active holiday.

For this reason, Cala Montjoi Holiday Resort sets out this environmental policy statement, which applies to all activities and facilities within its scope, and undertakes a series of principles and commitments in environmental matters.

Main principles and commitments

- To involve all stakeholders in this matter, from Cala Montjoi staff and suppliers providing any type of goods or products to guests, through information and awareness actions aimed at preserving the surrounding environment and generating the lowest possible impact.
- To carry out all activities at the Holiday Resort in harmony with the values of protecting the natural area, based on an efficient management model for the territory, the environment and natural resources.
- To promote the geological, botanical, faunal, ecological and landscape values present in the area, as well as their understanding and interpretation.
- To promote energy efficiency and the use of renewable energy sources.
- To reduce water consumption as far as possible.
- To promote the selective collection of waste generated by guests by placing specific containers for each type of waste.
- To encourage environmental, educational, cultural and nature-awareness activities.
- To maintain the commitment to comply with the legal requirements applicable to the facilities and the natural environment of Cala Montjoi Holiday Resort.
- To supply propane gas as a replacement for diesel fuel.
- To implement house rules that inform guests about the fundamental rules of coexistence and about aspects related to the care of the facilities and green areas throughout the site.
- As a result, Cala Montjoi Holiday Resort has held the ISO 14001 environmental certificate since 2010, accredited by TUV Rheinland, implementing improvement objectives year after year and undergoing the annual inspections carried out by the certification body.

A privileged setting for diving

Cala Montjoi is a privileged location for diving. The area, with very limited development, lies in a secluded, still unspoilt and exceptionally beautiful setting.

Nearby, some of the best-known dive sites in the Cap de Creus Natural Park offer seabeds characterised by extensive gorgonian walls, where lobsters, moray eels, conger eels and countless other species delight every diver.
